It is proposed to conduct a selection for formation of a panel for filling up of vacancies in Junior Engineer /Works in Level-6 against 15% Limited Departmental Competitive Examination (LDCE) in Civil Engineering Department of MDU Division. The details are as follow:

1. Break up of Vacancies :

The above vacancy is provisional as the final vacancies will be decided after finalization of Junior Engineer/Works/25 % Promotional Quota in Civil Engineering Department.

It is therefore applications are invited from all eligible SC employees as the provisional vacancies are likely to change after completion of Promotional Quota and no further chance will be given for applying to the selection to the post of Junior Engineer/Works against 15 % LDCE Quota. Mere calling volunteers for the provisional vacancies will not confer any right to empanel in the Junior Engineer/ Works against 15 % LDCE Quota. Empanelment will be done for the final vacancies decided after completion of JE/Works against 25% Promotional Quota exam.

2. Eligibility and Service Conditions:

Eligible Categories of Staff	<p>-Staff should be from the category of Skilled grades in Works Branch and Artizan(Helper) in Level-1 working in works cadre having experience of 3 years as on date of this notification.</p> <p>-Training period will not be counted towards the minimum 03 (three) years period except for the directly recruited Technician Gr.III who possess technical qualification and have undergone 6 months training.</p> <p>- Those who are working in an ex-cadre post but have a lien at Technician/Civil Engineering Department will be eligible, provided they satisfy the other conditions.</p>

ii.	Educational Qualification	-Should be in possession of educational qualification of ITI/Act Apprenticeship pass or 10 +2 in Science Stream (RBE 93/2022) or its equivalent with any of the Science subjects (or) Degree or Diploma in Civil Engineering or its sub stream. - In terms of Railway Board's letter No. E(NG) – II/2010/RR-1/17 Dated.08.12.2011 (RBE-165/2011), the diploma/Degree in Engineering obtained through distance mode except AMIETE will not be considered as eligible.
iii	Age	Upper age limit for UR employees is 47 years and Upper age limit for SC/ST employees is 52 years as on the date of issue of this notification.

3. Selection Procedure: The selection process comprises of Computer Based Test(CBT)followed by perusal of Service records. Only those who qualify in the CBT will be considered for subsequent stages of the selection.

The empanelment of the candidate will be subject to the condition mentioned below:

Securing of 60% marks in aggregate i.e. CBT and record of service is the criteria for placing on the panel subject to the extent of vacancies notified. Empanelment is purely on the basis of merit. There is no relaxation for SC/ST employees since the post is classified as Safety post.

1. The CBT will consist of questions in objective type, 10% of the marks on Official Language will be on optional basis. Totally 110 question will be asked out of which 100 question only to be attended.
2. Those who are eventually considered for posts as JE (Works) have to undergo 12 months training .During the period of training, they will enjoy the same privilege and status of category from which they are selected.
3. There will be no supplementary written examination for the above selection.
4. Last Date for submission of application to the Supervisory Official is 21.02.2025. Application from eligible volunteers in the prescribed proforma will be collected by the Supervisory Officials and sent in one bunch with a covering letter (showing the names of volunteers) to reach the undersigned on or before 25.02.2025. The office copy of the covering letter should be kept on file at the unit for future verification when needed.
Applications received after the last date prescribed will not be entertained.

The Supervisory shall also affix their signature & date while forwarding applications to this office. Incomplete applications, application received after the last date shall be summarily rejected.

In case of no volunteer's for the above selection, a 'NIL' statement may be sent to this Office.

1. Specification and quality control for items of works commonly used in Building and Bridge works-Brick work, Wood work, RCC, PSC, Plumbing work, White washing/Color washing, Painting etc.
2. Schedule of Rates-Scope & Coverage in general.
3. Inspection and maintenance of buildings, roads, structures, water supply and sanitary arrangements.
4. Leveling and setting out of works.
5. Earth work in Railway Projects.
6. Estimating quantities for building works.
7. Passenger Amenities at stations-categories of stations and minimum essential amenities.
8. Recoding of measurements and processing contractor's bills for payment.
9. Zonal contracts & work orders.
10. Schedule of Dimensions-specifically with reference to clearance for structures in PF/Stations, and overall moving dimensions.
